Third Trimester HIV Screening

Clinicians in Texas, including physicians or any other person permitted to attend woman, must test every pregnant woman under their care for HIV, syphilis, and hepatitis B unless she objects. The tests must take place during the pregnant woman's first pre natal visit and at delivery.

Effective January 1, 2010, the woman must be tested for HIV during her 3rd trimester unless she objects. If there is no record of her test result from the third trimester, then the woman must be tested at delivery, unless she objects.
